

April Block of the Month

White background

Easter colors for the others

Cutting Instructions

Background fabric: cut 6 squares 4" for triangles and 4 squares 2" for four patch. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of the 4" squares.



Medium: Cut 3 squares 4"

Dark: cut 5 squares 4"

Accent: cut 4 squares 2" for four patch

Piecing Instructions:

1. Stitch the background and **accent** 2" squares together to make 2 four-patch units as shown. Press the center back intersection seam open to make it lie flat. Should measure 3½"

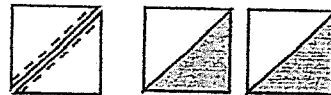


2. Place 4 of the 4" background squares right sides together onto 4 of the 4" **dark** squares. Stitch ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press toward the dark fabric. You will get 8 half-square triangle units. **Trim these so they measure 3½"**



Bloc-Loc or Tucker Trimmer will make squaring up easier.

3. Place 2 of the 4" background squares right sides together onto 2 of the 4" **medium** squares. Again, stitch on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Press toward the medium fabric. You will get 4 half-square triangle units. **Trim to measure 3½"**



4. Place the remaining 4" **medium** square right sided together onto the remaining 4" **dark** square. Draw a line and sew as above. Press toward the dark. You will get 2 hst units. **Trim to measure 3½"**



5. Arrange blocks in rows as shown.

Press rows in opposite directions, then press all rows down.
