

August Block of the Month Background-white Sunflowers and coordinating Colors

Cutting Instructions:

Measure twice, cut once!

Background fabric: Cut 4 rectangles 3 ½" x 6 ½". Cut 4 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½". Draw a diagonal line on the


wrong sides of the 3 1/2" squares.

Dark fabric: Cut 4 rectangles 3 ½" x 6 ½".

Medium fabric: Cut 4 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of each. Accent fabric: Cut 4 squares 3 ½" x 3 ½". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of each.

Piecing Instructions:

1. place a 3 ½" background (bg) square on a Dark rectangle with diagonal line as shown. Sew on line, then press toward triangle and trim.



2. Place the Accent square on one side of the bg rectangle; sew on the line. Press in direction of arrow. Trim seam to ¼". Repeat with Medium square on bg rectangle as shown below.









3. Stitch the step 1 units and the step 2 units together into a square unit. Make 4.



4. Stitch the units together, rotating them as shown. Press. Block should measure 12½".
