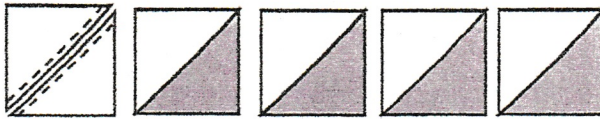

Cutting Instructions:

Background: cut (8) 4" x 4" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of each.

Each of the 4 colors: cut (2) 4" x 4" squares.

1. Place a background square right sides together with a color square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the line. Cut on the line. Press seams toward color. Square up to $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Use your *Bloc-Loc* or *Tucker Trimmer* for ease!



2. Repeat this process with each of the 3 other colors.
3. Using four different colors of HST units, sew together into a square that measures $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ", pressing seams as you sew. Repeat to make 4 of these units.
