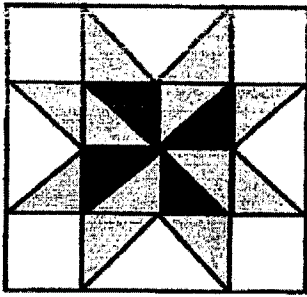


February Block of the Month



Background white
Please use pink, red or purples.

Cutting Instructions:

White Background fabric: cut 1 square $7\frac{1}{2}$ " and 4 squares $3\frac{1}{2}$ "

Medium: cut 4 squares $4\frac{1}{4}$ ". Draw a diagonal line corner to corner on the wrong side of the squares.

Dark: cut 2 squares 4 ".

Accent: cut 2 squares 4 ". Draw a diagonal line on wrong side.



Piecing Instructions:

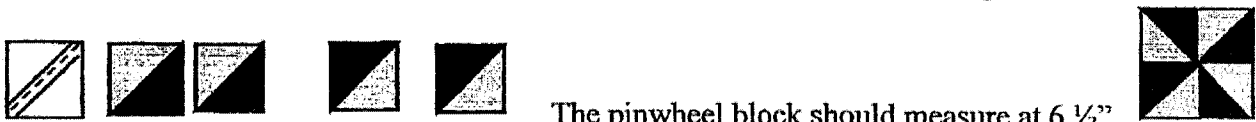
- Place 2 of the medium 4 " squares on opposite corners of the $7\frac{1}{4}$ " background square right sides together. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the dark triangles; you will get 2 units. Place another 4 " medium square on the corner of the large triangle; stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line again. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the med. triangles. Repeat with the other triangle unit. You will get 4 finished flying geese units.



Trim geese units to $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Use your Wing Clipper, Ultimate Flying Geese Tool, or Bloc-Loc Flying Geese to make it easier.

- Place a dark and an accent square right sides together. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the accent. **Trim squares to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".** (Do you have Bloc-Loc or Tucker Trimmer?) Repeat to get 4 finished dark/accent half square triangles. Assemble into a 4-patch as shown.



The pinwheel block should measure at $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

- Stitch 2 of the flying geese units on opposite sides of the center square. Press to the center. Then add the 4 remaining $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to opposite ends of the remaining flying geese units. Press to outside.



Assemble block as shown; press seams to the outside, or press open.

Block measures $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".
