

July Block of the Month White Background Red, Blue and prints

Cutting Instructions:

Measure twice, cut once!

Background fabric: Cut 1 square 7-3/4", 4 squares 3-1/2".

Dark fabric: Cut 4 squares 4-1/4". Draw a diagonal line on the wrong sides of the squares.

Medium fabric: Cut 2 squares 4-1/4" x 4-1/4". Cut both in half diagonally once.

Light fabric: Cut 2 squares 3-1/2 ". Accent fabric: Cut 2 square 3-1/2 ".

Piecing Instructions:

1. Place 2 of the dark 41/4" squares on opposite corners of the 73/4" background square right sides together. Stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to the dark triangles; you will get 2 units. Place another 41/4" dark square on the corner of the large triangle; stitch a scant 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line again. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the dark triangles. Repeat with the other triangle unit. You will get 4 finished flying geese units. Trim geese units to 6½" x 3½".














2. Place a light 3-1/2" square and accent 3-1/2" square right sides together. Stitch 1/4" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut on the line. Repeat. Press toward the accent triangle to get a total of 4 half square triangle units. Trim squares to 21/2".









Piece the 4 units together into a pinwheel as shown.

Press.

3. Place 2 medium triangles on 2 opposite sides of the pinwheel unit. Press toward the medium. Sew 2 on remaining 2 sides of the unit. Press. Trim this unit to 61/2" x 61/2" with pinwheel centered and there will be more than 1/4" on all 4 sides. The pinwheel will float against the "dark"

4. Stitch the block together as shown with background corner squares. Press. Block should

measure 121/2".
