Celebrating America 250!

June - Arizona

Colors – Red, White & Navy

Cutting Instructions:

Piece A – cut 4 white - 2-1/2” squares
(corners)

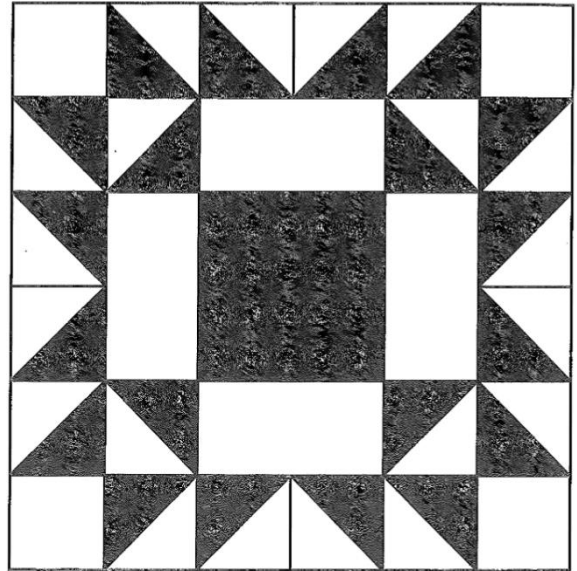
Piece B – cut 2 white & 2 navy or red
6-1/4” squares = 16 Half Square Triangles
(see instructions below)

Plus 1 white and 1 navy or red 4” squares
To make **4 HST** (sewing instructions below)

This will give you 20 HST

Piece C – cut 4 white rectangles
4-1/2” x 2-1/2”

Piece D - cut 1 red or navy 4-1/2” square

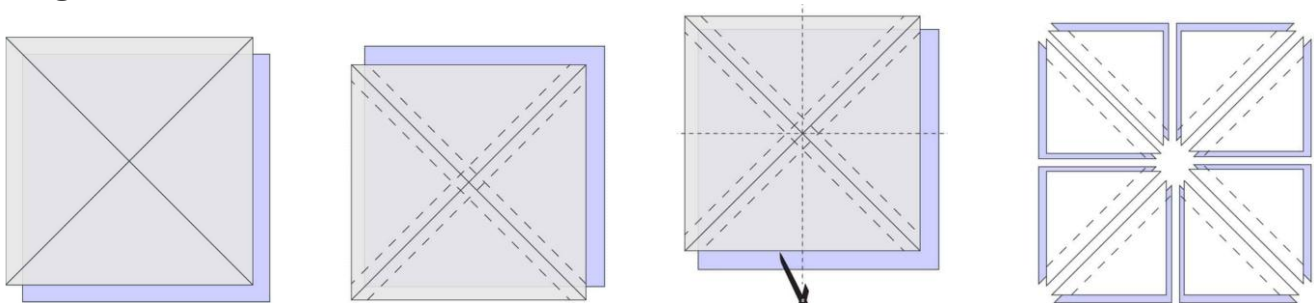


A = Half Square Triangle Sewing Instructions to cut 8 at a time:

Use the 6-1/4” - “B” Squares (white and red or navy)

1. Draw diagonal lines on the white squares
2. Place right sides together (1 white & 1 other color)
3. Stich 1/4” on both sides of the diagonal line
4. Cutting instructions – see #3 figure below

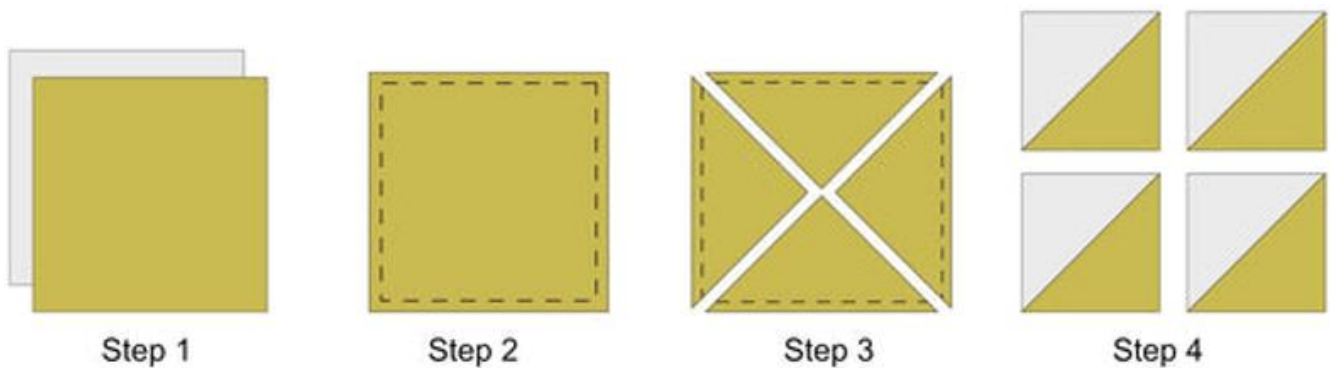
Diagram for 8 HST:



B - Half Square Triangle Sewing Instructions to cut 4 at a time:

Use the 4-1/4" – "B" squares - (1 white and 1 red or 1 navy)

1. Place right sides together (1 white & 1 other color)
2. Stich 1/4" from the raw edges (figure 2 below)
3. Cutting instructions – see figure 3 in "A" below



Press to set the stitching and then open the block, pressing towards the dark fabric

Trim all HST to measure 2-1/2" squares

Arrange pieces per the diagram below:

Everything outlined in **Red** are half square triangles!

Sew pieces together by **Columns**

1. Sew blocks in column one together
2. Sew blocks in column two together
3. Etc.

Sew columns one and two together, and then column three.
