

Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival's 2017 Showcase Challenge

Are you ready for a new quilt making challenge? The Kansas City Regional Quilt Festival committee has announced the requirements for the **2017 Festival Showcase Challenge Quilt.**

Two quilts will be chosen from the entries to hang inside the Plexiglas Showcase at the Festival entryway (front and back). Depending on the amount of available floor space, non-winning entries may be hung as a Special Collection inside the Festival's quilt show viewing area.

Who can enter? Any member, or group of members, from any of the KCRQF Participating Guilds can enter a quilt. Everyone involved in the construction of the quilt must be an active guild member. Only the hand or machine quilting service may be obtained from outside the participating guild membership.

To get you started, here are the requirements:

Quilt must measure 83" x 83"

The only fabric colors allowed are those that appear in the KCRQF logo:

Lime / Apple / Bright Green
Sunshine / Lemon / Golden Yellow
Raspberry Pink / Pinky Red
Royal / Midnight / Dark Teal or Dark Turquoise Blue
Black
White

Any combination of the listed colors can be used, but no other colors of fabric can be added. Exact match to logo color is not required, but must be within a "reasonable variation" of those colors. **Think BRIGHT!** Go to www.kcrqf.com or check with your guild's Festival representative for examples of the logo.

Theme/Style/Technique are open to the quilt maker(s) creative imagination.

Quilt must have a hanging sleeve sewn on the back of the quilt (not pinned)

Quilt must have a label attached to the quilt listing each participant's name and the name of the guild from which they are a member.

Quilts must be registered no later than May 1, 2017. Registration forms will be made available to all participating guilds by September 2016.
