Celebrating America 250!**

May – New Hampshire

Colors – Red, White & Navy


Cutting Instructions:

Piece A – cut 16 white 2-1/2” squares

Piece B - Cut four red 4-1/2” squares

Piece C – cut 4 navy, 2 red and 2 white
4-1/2” x 2-1/2” rectangles

Piece D – cut 1 navy 4-1/2” square




Sewing Instructions:

The corners are “square in a square”. Just like we did in the January BOM.


Using a red square and four white squares, sew a square in a square patch.

Repeat for a total of 4 red / white square in a square unit.

Square in a Square:



Arrange all fabric pieces per the lay out diagram below



Instructions: - You know what to do – LOL

Row 1 & 3 – corners are a “square in a square”

Row 1 & 3 – middle block: sew “C” rectangle to B rectangle

Sew the three mini blocks together per the diagram and you have Row 1 done.

Row 2 – sew together per the diagram. It’s super easy.

Now sew the completed rows together (row 1 to row 2 and then sew on row 3)
