

**2026 Miami Country Quilt Guild Block of the Month
Celebrating America 250!**

September – New Mexico

Colors – Red, White & Navy

Cutting Instructions:

HST's = Piece A – cut 1 White and 1 Navy or Red 8-1/4" squares = Makes 8 HST

And 1 white and 1 navy or red 5-1/2" squares
= makes 4 HST

Piece B – cut 5 Navy or Red 3" squares

Piece C – Cut 2 light and 1 navy or red 1-3/8" x 14" Strips

Piece D – Cut 3 strips light and
3 strips dark = 1-3/8" W x 18" L
You will make four 9 Patch Blocks

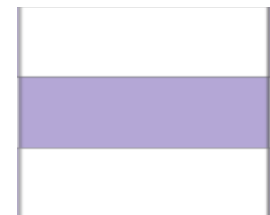


Sewing instructions:

A = HST – see June BOM Sewing Instructions

B = nothing to do until time to assemble the entire block

C = Sew the strips as follows: White – Navy or Red – White
Press seams and Cut into 3" squares

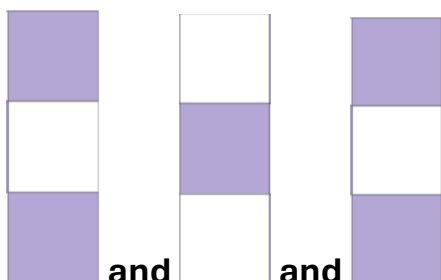


D = sew the strips as follows:

2 strips of "navy or red" – white – "navy or red"

1 strip of white – "navy or red" – white

Cut each strip into 1-3/8" widths



Sew the three columns together to make your 9 patch blocks

Layout the blocks using the diagram below

Sew each block in a row together and then sew the rows together.
